

NARL and UAF: Growing Up Together in Alaska

- UAF's Geophysical Institute: created by Congress in 1946
- "establishment of a geophysical institute at the University of Alaska...dedicated to the maintenance of geophysical research concerning the arctic regions..."

- Office of Naval Research established in 1946
- ONR's Arctic Research Laboratory established in 1947

For decades, the only U.S.
 laboratory devoted to fulltime
 support of basic research in the
 Arctic

1954: UA and ONR Contract

- University became the operator of the ARL
- Director and staff were
 University employees 1954-1980
- Dr. Laurence Irving was the first Director of NARL and established the first research program, prior to 1954





 $1 \text{ PB} = 10000000000000000B = 10^{15} \text{bytes} = 1000 \text{ terabytes}$


